confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 10.43 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 8700. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1928. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.133 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.
