CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the water of KLAMATH RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION of 215.21 ACRES.

The right was perfected under PERMIT 4349. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 29, 1919. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed 2.68 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source. The use of water under this right for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

This certificate is issued to correct a scrivener's error contained in the certificate recorded at page 76821, State Record of Water Right Certificates. Certificate 76821 contained an incomplete legal description for the place of use under the right. This certificate supersedes Certificate 76821.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 3947, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered on June 25, 2001, at Special Order Volume 55, Page 234, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
