confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER AND BEACH CRREK, tributaries of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 2.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit E-134. The date of priority is APRIL 1, 1912. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.026 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE% NW%, SECTION 25, T 13 S, R 30 E, W.M.; (OLD PANAMA DITCH) SOUTH 72 DEGREES EAST, 2705 FEET FROM THE NW CORNER, SECTION 25.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE% SW% 2.0 ACRES SECTION 24 TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

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The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
