CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

W.M. BENNETT  
MT. VERNON, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of SPRINGS AND SLOUGH, tributaries of the JOHN DAY RIVER, and the JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 28.1 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1872.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed - John Day River - 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated from April 1 to September 30; further limited to one acre-foot per acre per calendar month to July 1 and 3/4 acre-foot per acre thereafter; total five acre-feet per acre for season, measured at point of diversion.

Springs and slough - 1/40 cubic foot per second per acre irrigated to June 1 and 1/80 cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to one acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and four acre-feet per acre during season April 1 to September 30, measured at point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  28.1 ACRES  
SECTION 24  
TOWNSHIP 13 SOUTH, RANGE 29 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 24885, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JUL 3 1 2001, approving Transfer Application 8475.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
