CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 20.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50793. The date of priority is MAY 30, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.258 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. HANNON DLC 42, TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.; 250 FEET SOUTH AND 890 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed, and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.


Failure to comply with any of the provision of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use, without waste, on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
