CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ALISA K. COLEMAN 285 RENE DRIVE SHADY COVE, OREGON 97539

confirms the right to use the waters of LOST CREEK RESERVOIR CONSTRUCTED UNDER PERMIT R-8142, a tributary of ROGUE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 0.6 ACRE.

This right was perfected under Permit 52166. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 3, 1993. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.4 ACRE-FEET STORED WATER, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOST CREEK RESERVOIR - NW 1/4, SECTION 26, TOWNSHIP 33 SOUTH, RANGE 1 EAST, W.M.; AND

ROGUE RIVER RE-DIVERSION - LOT 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 660 FEET NORTH AND 1065 FEET EAST OF THE CENTER 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to 4 ½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 7 (SW 1/4 NE 1/4) 0.6 ACRE SECTION 21 TOWNSHIP 34 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The Director may require the water user to install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. If the Director notifies the water user to install a meter or other measuring device, the water user shall install such device within the period stated in the notice. Such installation period shall not be less than 90 days unless special circumstances warrant a shorter installation period. Once installed, the water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order and shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative measuring procedures for review and approval.
- B. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The use of water under this right is subject to the terms and conditions of Water Service Contract No. 4-07-10-W0991 or a satisfactory replacement between the Bureau of Reclamation and the water user.

The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening to prevent fish from entering the diversion.

Failure to comply with any of the provision of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use, without waste, on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

The Director of the Water Resources Department finds the use of water described by this right, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

In processing the application towards issuance of the permit, it appears that a clerical error was inadvertently made in limiting the duty of water to not exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year. In the issuance of this certificate, the duty of water has been raised to 4 ½ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, in keeping with the customary policy and determination of this office of the proper maximum limits.
