## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

WALBURGA LACHNER BAKER, OR 97814

confirms the right to use the water of the POWDER RIVER, a tributary of the SNAKE RIVER, and SPRINGS IN NW¼ SW¼ SECTION 34 for IRRIGATION of 97.15 ACRES.

The right was confirmed by decree of Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Baker County and is of record in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director in Volume 6, Page 291. The date of priority is 1887 for Tract No. 1; July 5, 1902, for Tract No. 2; and 1887 for Tract No. 3. The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purpose aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed ONE FORTIETH OF ONE CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND PER ACRE, and shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 75875, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUG 0 9 2001, and recorded in Special Order Volume 55, Page 834, canceling a portion of said water right. Water Right Certificate 75875 superseded Water Right Certificate 4293.
