CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of LITTLE BEAR CREEK SPRING AND TONY SPRING tributaries to BEAR CREEK for STOCK WATERING.

This right was perfected under Permit 47853. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FROM EACH SOURCE PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM THE COMBINED SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.02 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LITL BR CR SPRING: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 23 TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.; 1100 FEET NORTH AND 1100 FEET EAST OF SW CORNER OF SECTION 23; AND

TONY SPRING: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 OF SECTION 36, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.; 2300 FEET SOUTH AND 900 FEET EAST OF SW CORNER OF SECTION 36.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.


A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 LITTLE BEAR CREEK SPRING  
SECTION 23  
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

NW 1/4 SW 1/4 TONY SPRING  
SECTION 36  
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
