CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of CREEPERS SPRING AND DRIBBLE SPRING tributaries to CAMP CREEK for STOCK WATERING.

This right was perfected under Permit 47866. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FROM EACH SOURCE PROVIDED THE TOTAL QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM THE COMBINED SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.015 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

CREEPERS SPRING: NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; 2500 FEET NORTH AND 700 FEET WEST OF SE CORNER OF SECTION 31; AND

DRIBBLE SPRING: SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; 1200 FEET NORTH AND 2100 FEET WEST OF SE CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4 CREEPERS SPRING  
SECTION 31  
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

SW 1/4 SE 1/4 DRIBBLE SPRING  
SECTION 32  
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
