## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of A SPRING (SW-2) a tributary of FOX CREEK for STOCK WATERING.

This right was perfected under Permit 49011. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 24, 1981. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS).

The point of diversion is located as follows:

A SPRING (SW-2): NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH,

RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.; 700 FEET SOUTH AND 900 FEET WEST FROM THE PROJECTED SECTION CORNER OF SECTION

19, 20, 29, AND 30,

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 A SPRING (SW-2) SECTION 30

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 30 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is

available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
