CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to Certify, That W. V. COPELAND

of Fort Klamath, State of Oregon has a right to the use of

the waters of Anna Creek tributary, Wood River

for the purpose of Irrigation of 45 acres of land, domestic and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for
Klamath County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order
Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 2, at page 21; that the priority
of the right thereby confirmed dates from 1908

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an
amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed .75 cubic foot per second
from April 1st to July 20th of each year and thereafter until the close of the irri-
gation season .375 cubic feet per second, or the equivalent thereof in case of rotation;
the total quantity delivered not to exceed four acre feet for each acre irrigated

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant
(or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

10 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and 35 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{2}$ SW $\frac{1}{2}$, in Section 31, Twp. 32 S. R.
7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.W.M., being a total of 45 acres.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation
system ordered by the proper State Officer. The right to use water for domestic and
stock purposes shall continue throughout the year.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place
of use herein described.
