CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST
P.O. BOX 909
JOHN DAY, OREGON 97845

confirms the right to use the waters of OAK SPRING a tributary to
LITTLE BEAR CREEK AND BULL SPRING a tributary to BEAR CREEK for
LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 49321. The date of priority is
AUGUST 26, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled
is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not
exceed 0.02 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS).

The point of diversion is located as follows:

OAK SPRING: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.; 100 FEET SOUTH AND 2000 FEET
WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 23; AND

BULL SPRING: SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH,
RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.; 2300 SOUTH AND 2100 EAST FROM
THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant
is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 OAK SPRING
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

SE 1/4 NW 1/4 BULL SPRING
SECTION 29
TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted
to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use
confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is
available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for
maintaining instream flows.
