CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. MALHEUR NATIONAL FOREST

confirms the right to use the waters of DYE SPRING a tributary to CAMP CREEK for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 49324. The date of priority is AUGUST 26, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS).

The point of diversion is located as follows:

DYE SPRING: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH,  
RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; 200 FEET SOUTH AND 2200 FEET  
WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 30.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 DYE SPRING  
SECTION 30  
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
