## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DEADWOOD SPRING AND ASPEN SPRING, tributaries of FAWN CREEK for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 49528. The date of priority is MAY 20, 1985. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.015 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS) FROM EACH SOURCE PROVIDED THE TOTAL. QUANTITY DIVERTED FROM THE COMBINED SOURCES SHALL NOT EXCEED 0.015 CFS, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

DEADWOOD SPRING: SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,

RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; 2600 FEET SOUTH AND 300 FEET

EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 27; AND

ASPEN SPRING: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH,

RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.; 300 FEET SOUTH AND 2200 FEET

WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 33.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4

DEADWOOD SPRING

SECTION 27

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

NW 1/4 NE 1/4

ASPEN SPRING

SECTION 33

TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
