CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of SQUAW CREEK SPRING, a tributary of COTTONWOOD CREEK for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 28260. The date of priority is MARCH 5, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SQUAW CREEK SPRING: SW 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 25, TOWNSHIP 18
SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.; SOUTH 11°
EAST, A DISTANCE OF 2145 FEET FROM THE
NW CORNER OF SECTION 25.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NW 1/4 SECTION 25 SQUAW CREEK SPRING
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
