CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of W-4 SPRING #3, a tributary of BRANSON CREEK for ANIMAL DRINKING WATER.

This right was perfected under Permit 46431. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 19, 1980. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, measured at the point of diversion from the stream, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

W-4 SPRING #3: SE 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 30, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH,
RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.; 640 FEET NORTH AND 1920 FEET
EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 30.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SW 1/4 W-4 SPRING #3
SECTION 30
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
