CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of 4919-RIMROCK SPRING, a tributary of COAL MINE CREEK for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE CONSUMPTION.

This right was perfected under Permit 48347. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed .01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

4919 RIMROCK SPRING: SW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 19
SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 450 FEET
NORTH AND 200 FEET EAST FROM THE SW
CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 SW 1/4 4919 RIMROCK SPRING
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
