CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of GULLY SPRING-1083, a tributary of MIDDLE FORK of the MALHEUR RIVER for LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE CONSUMPTION.

This right was perfected under Permit 48373. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 19, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

GULLY SPRING-1083: NE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 29, TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH,  
RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.; 600 FEET SOUTH AND 520  
FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 29.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NE 1/4 GULLY SPRING-1083  
SECTION 29  
TOWNSHIP 18 SOUTH, RANGE 34 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
