CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of BRANSON SPRING-4839, a tributary of BRANSON CREEK for LIVESTOCK and WILDLIFE.

This right was perfected under Permit 49199. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 30, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.0 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

BRANSON SPRING-4839: NW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 31, TOWNSHIP 10  
SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.; 900 FEET  
SOUTH AND 1450 FEET WEST FROM THE NE  
CORNER OF SECTION 31.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 NE 1/4 BRANSON SPRING-4839  
SECTION 31  
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
