confirms the right to store the waters FROM TWO UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAMS, tributaries of CAMP CREEK, in POND 5 AND MEADOW POND RESERVOIRS FOR LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8844. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1982. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 0.4 ACRE-FOOT (AF); BEING 0.20 AF IN EACH RESERVOIR.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

POND 5 & MEADOW POND
SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 33
TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 31 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the waters for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
