## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to store the waters of FIVE UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAMS, tributaries of BURNT CABIN CREEK, in DAMON CREEK 0, DAMON CREEK 1, DAMON CREEK 2, DAMON CREEK 3, AND BURNT CABIN POND RESERVOIRS for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8872. The date of priority is OCTOBER 4, 1982. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 1.0 ACRE-FOOT(AF), BEING 0.20 AF IN EACH RESERVOIR.

The reservoirs are located as follows:

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
