confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 102.6 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 3163. The date of priority is OCTOBER 23, 1916. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.28 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, if available at the original point of diversion: SW½ NE¾, SECTION 29, T 13 S, R 30 E, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

NE% SW%, SECTION 20; SW% SW%, SECTION 21, T 13 S, R 29 E, W.M.; SW% NE%, SECTION 29, T 13 S, R 30 E, W.M.; (ADDITIONAL) 2530 FEET NORTH AND 2810 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER, SECTION 20; (BOYCE DITCH) SOUTH 27 DEGREES 30 MINUTES EAST, 1817 FEET FROM THE W% CORNER, SECTION 21; (BLUE MOUNTAIN DITCH) 565 FEET NORTH AND 2320 FEET WEST FROM THE E% CORNER, SECTION 29.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.0 acre-foot per acre for each acre irrigated during any month prior to July 1, and thereafter 3/4 of one acre-foot per acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a total

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diversion of not to exceed 5.0 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season from April 1 to September 30 of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install headgates and measuring devices:

The diversion works shall include an in-line flowmeter, a weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

The type and plans of the measuring device be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and that the weir or measuring device be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, together with that diverted at the old points of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed
by Certificate 74275, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT
modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director
entered, approving Transfer Application
8851.

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The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
