## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

MCCLELLAN O. AND DOROTHY B. KNAPP ROUTE 2, BOX 1060 ROSEBURG, OREGON 97470

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 90.8 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 28110. The date of priority is MAY 8, 1962. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.131 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE% NW%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN N. DAY DLC 40, SECTION 31, T 25 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 700 FEET NORTH AND 3620 FEET WEST FROM THE E% CORNER, SECTION 31.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2% acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right to use of water from the Umpqua River is limited to the period when the flow of the Umpqua River is more than 525 cubic feet per second at tidewater.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
