CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of the NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 18.4 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 50793. The date of priority is MAY 30, 1989. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.2304 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE¼ NE¼, SECTION 33, AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. HANNON DLC 42, T 26 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 250 FEET SOUTH AND 890 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER, SECTION 33.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW¼ SW¼ 6.00 ACRES
 SW¼ SW¼ 6.84 ACRES
 BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. HANNON DLC 42
 SECTION 27

NE¼ SE¼ 0.60 ACRE
 SE¼ SE¼ 4.96 ACRES
 BOTH AS PROJECTED WITHIN G. HANNON DLC 42
 SECTION 27
 TOWNSHIP 26 SOUTH, RANGE 6 WEST, W.M.

Diversion screening or fish passage facilities shall be designed, installed and operated to Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this right may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the right.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use, without waste, on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.


This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 77020, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered OCT 15 2001 , approving Transfer Applications 7812, 7813 and 8243.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
