CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

OLIVER HAINES
ELKTON, OREGON 97436

confirms the right to use the waters of the UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of the PACIFIC OCEAN, for IRRIGATION OF 34.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 20332. The date of priority is MAY 10, 1951. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.431 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, AS PROJECTED WITHIN HARTS DLC #42, SECTION 19,
T 22 S, R 7 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:



The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
