confirms the right to use the waters of BELL SPRING, a tributary of GATE CREEK for LIVESTOCK and WILDLIFE.

This right was perfected under Permit 48720. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 13, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:


SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 11, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.; 1350 FEET SOUTH and 700 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 11.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4  
SECTION 11  
TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 10 EAST, W.M.
