The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NW 1/4, SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 4 SOUTH, RANGE 11 EAST, W.M.; 2640 FEET SOUTH and 1580 FEET EAST FROM THE NW CORNER OF SECTION 15.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
