confirms the right to use the waters of PEAVY CREEK, a tributary of NORTH FORK JOHN DAY RIVER for DOMESTIC USE for PEAVY CABIN.

This right was perfected under Permit 48693. The date of priority is JULY 21, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.0 GALLONS OF WATER PER MINUTE.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.; 2300 FEET NORTH AND 825 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 35.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NW 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 35 TOWNSHIP 7 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all pricr rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
