CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

U.S. WALLOWA-WHITMAN NATIONAL FOREST
P.O. BOX 907
BAKER CITY, OREGON 97814

confirms the right to use the waters of DURF SPRING, a tributary of
TROUT CREEK for STOCK WATER.

This right was perfected under Permit 48823. The date of priority
is SEPTEMBER 7, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is
entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and
shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in
case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 14, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.;
1584 FEET SOUTH AND 1320 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION
14.


The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be
ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is
appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 14
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is
restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use
described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when
sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights,
including rights for maintaining instream flows.
