## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of ANTELOPE SPRING, a tributary of TROUT CREEK for STOCK WATER.

This right was perfected under Permit 49069. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 29, 1982. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.50 GALLONS PER MINUTE, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 12, TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.; 1100 FEET NORTH AND 1000 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 12.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4 SECTION 12 TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
