confirms the right to use the waters of FOX SPRING, a tributary of OWLSLEY CREEK for LIVESTOCK.

This right was perfected under Permit 50493. The date of priority is OCTOBER 3, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.004 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 35, TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.; 1800 FEET SOUTH AND 2300 FEET WEST FROM THE NE CORNER OF SECTION 35.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4
SECTION 35
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
