confirms the right to store the waters from an UNNAMED INTERMITTENT STREAM, tributary to the FIVE POINTS CREEK in MEADOW POND RESERVOIR FOR LIVESTOCK WATERING.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8615. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 15, 1980. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 0.10 ACRE-FOOT.

The reservoir is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4
SECTION 32
TOWNSHIP 1 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or the provision of other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the waters for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
