CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Ukiah , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Camas Creek

under Pormit No. 8318 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 9, 1927;

that the amount of water to which such right is cutilled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.0 cubic foot per second;

The point of diversion is located in the $\mathbb{N}^{\mathbb{N}}$ of Section 13 , Township 58 , Range 51E, W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows: Lenz Ditch 28.8 acres in the NW4SW4, Section 13, and 1.4 acres in the NW4SW4, Section 14. Weissenfluh Ditch 8.6 acres in the NW4W4, 18.6 acres in the NW4W4, 16.6 acres in the SW4NW4 0.5 acre in the SE4NW4, Section 13, and 0.1 acre in the SE4NW4, Section 14. Fownship 5 South, Hange 51 Fast of the Willamette Meridian in Umstilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the vater rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728, Oregon Laws.
