has a right to the use of

the waters of A small Creek in Sections 9 and 10, T. 35 S. R. 18 E. W.M., a tributary of Chewaucan River and Antelope Creek, a tributary of Chewaucan River for the purpose of the irrigation of 33.4 acres of land, and stock use.

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 5 , at page 1 ; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed a rate of diversion of 1/25 of a cubic foot per second per acre, and the aggregate quantity set forth in connection with each tract described below; and said rights shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

Proof No. 111 for the irrigation of 25 acres from a small Creek in Sections 9 and 10, T. 35 S. R. 18 E., W.M. -- 13 acres in the SEt of NEt, and 12 acres in the NEt of SEt of Section 9, T. 35 S. R. 18 E. W.M., in Lake County, Oregon.

Proof No. 112 for the irrigation of 8.4 acres from Antelope Creek, -- being 6.3 acres in the NW: of SE;, and 2.1 acres in the SW; of SE; of Section 22, T. 35 S. R. 18 E.W.M., in Lake County, Oregon.

All of the above described lands shall be limited to 3.9 acre feet per acre during each irrigation season, being the period from April 1 to September 15 of each year.

NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supersede that certain certificate issued to E. S. McDonald July 15, 1922 and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Volume 4, Page 3668, in accordance with an order of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Lake County, dated November 5, 1928, in the case of E. S. McDonald, Plaintiff, vs. Robert Wilson and Rhea Luper, Defendants; the effect of said Court order being to correct the description of the land under Proof No. 112, and to reduce the acreage from 15 to 8.4 acres of land.

The right to the use of the water for irrigation purposes is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
