CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.L. DEARDORF PRAIRIE CITY, OREGON 97869

confirms the right to use the waters of REYNOLDS CREEK, a tributary of the JOHN DAY RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 120.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for GRANT County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1868.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 3.00 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) TO JUNE 1 AND 1.50 CFS THEREAFTER DURING THE PERIOD APRIL 1 TO SEPTEMBER 30 or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

JOHN LAURENCE DITCH - SWY NEW, SECTION 26, T 13 S, R 34 E,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, to June 1 and ONE-EIGHTIETH cubic foot per second per acre thereafter; further limited to 1.0 acre-foot per calendar month to June 1 and 4.0 acre-feet per acre during the season April 1 to September 30, measured at the point of diversion.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 51854, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered _______, approving Transfer Application 8343.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
