CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

D. E. GILMAN HEPPNER, OREGON 97836 SUPERSEDED BY CERT. NO. 293676

confirms the right to use the waters of RHEA CREEK, a tributary of WILLOW CREEK, for IRRIGATION OF 111.8 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for MORROW County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 73. The dates of priority are 1874 FOR 96.8 ACRES AND 1879 FOR 15.0 ACRES.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.61 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND (CFS) AS OF PRIORITY DATE 1874 AND 0.25 CFS AS OF PRIORITY DATE 1879, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

GAY, GILMAN, AND BELLENBROCK DITCH SWY SEY, SECTION 21, T 3 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 310 FEET NORTH AND 72220 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 21.

COX AND BELLENBROCK DITCH : SWY SEX SECTION 28, T 3 S, R 25 E, W.M.; 800 FEET NORTH AND 1450 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 28.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-SIXTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
