confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the BEAR CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 50.7 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-10114. The date of priority is MAY 31, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 152.7 GALLONS PER MINUTE or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

SW% SW%, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SECTION 27, T 4 S, R 1 E, W.M.; 340 FEET NORTH AND 1170 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 27.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
