CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

C. E. TRAVILLION  
45 E. WATTS STREET  
PORTLAND, OR 97217

confirms the right to use the waters of WEST FORK CLEAR CREEK, EAST FORK CLEAR CREEK, DRY GULCH, SPRING CREEK, SALMON CREEK, LIGHTNING CREEK, and OLIVE CREEK, tributaries of the NORTH FORK BURNT RIVER, for the purpose of MINING.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Grant County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the Water Resources Director, in Volume 15, at Page 461. The date of priority is 1865.

The amount of water to which such right is entitled for the purposes aforesaid is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose and shall not exceed:

8 cubic feet per second from West Fork Clear Creek;  
4 cubic feet per second from East Fork Clear Creek;  
4 cubic feet per second from Dry Gulch;  
4 cubic feet per second from Spring Creek;  
4 cubic feet per second from Salmon Creek;  
2 cubic feet per second from Lightning Creek; and  
1 cubic feet per second from Olive Creek.

The amount of water is further limited to a diversion of 2.50 cubic feet per second, measured at the split box, at San Lou Flat in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 11, Township 10 South, Range 35 East.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant, is as follows:

TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 35.5 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 25914, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT canceled by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director on PC 98-4, entered on November 29, 2001, and recorded at Special Order Volume 55, Page 1189, canceling a portion of said water right.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regards to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations in said decree.
