Supplemental Irrigation under Permit No. 7227 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1926;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

5.02 cubic feet per second:

The point of diversion is located in the NE NE OF Section 28 , Township 98, Range 45E, W. M. The use hereunder for irrigation shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other ight existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per were, or its equivalent in case of rotation.

A description of the lands irrigated under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant (if for irrigation or any other purpose), is as follows: '4 acres in the NEINE, 6 acres in the SWINE, 8 acres in the SEINE, Section 35, 40 acres in the NEINE, 40 acres in the NVINE, 40 acres in the NW1NW1, 30 acres in the SENNE, 21.5 acres in the SW1NE, 25.5 acres in the SENNW1, 36.5 acres in the SW1NW2, Section 36, 37 acres in the SENNE, Section 25, Township 9 South, Range 45 . 3.5 acres in the NW1SE, 7.0 acres in the NELSW1, 3.5 acres in the SENNE, Section 20, 4.0 acres in the 3.5 acres in the SELSWI, 8. NELSE, 3 acres in the NELL 55 acres in the SWANWA, Section 30, and 25 acres in the NWASWA, Section 31. Township 9 South, Hange 46 Dast of the Willamette Meridian, being a total of 418 acres in Baker County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for any purpose is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

After the expiration of fifty years from the date of this certificate or on the expiration of any federal power license issued in connection with this right, and after not less than two years notice in writing to the holder hereof, the State of Oregon, or any municipality thereof, shall have the right to take over the dams, plants and other structures and all appurtenances thereto which have been constructed for the purpose of devoting to beneficial use the water rights specified herein, upon condition that before taking possession the State or municipality shall pay not to exceed the fair value of the property so taken, plus such reasonable damages, if any, to valuable, serviceable and dependable property of the holder of this certificate, not taken over, as may be caused by the severance therefrom of the property taken in accordance with the provisions of section 5728, Oregon Laws.
