## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

confirms the right to use the waters of DEER CREEK, a tributary of THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 1.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 48025. The date of priority is SEPTEMBER 2, 1983. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.023 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW% SW%, SECTION 24, T 27 S, R 5 W, W.M.; 1240 FEET NORTH AND 840 FEET EAST FROM THE SW CORNER OF SECTION 24.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:
