## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of EAST CREEK OF EAST PINE CREEK, SPRING AND WASTEWATER, tributary of PINE CREEK for IRRIGATION OF 5.0 ACRES, DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE FOR TRACT 2.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for BAKER County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 11, at Page 232. The date of priority is 1881 FOR TRACT 2.

The amount of water used for irrigation under this right is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) per acre, measured at the point of diversion and a total limitation of 1.0 acre-foot per acre during July, 1.0 acre-foot per acre during August, and 0.5 acre-foot per acre during September, of each year.

The point of diversion is located as follows:
