confirms the right to store the waters from an UNNAMED STREAM, LOCATED IN THE JOHN DAY BASIN in FAWN CREEK RESERVOIR #1 for LIVESTOCK.

The right to store these waters was perfected under Reservoir Permit R-8525. The date of priority is OCTOBER 21, 1982. The amount of water entitled to be stored each year under this right is not more than 1.0 ACRE-FOOT.


The reservoir is located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4
SECTION 34
TOWNSHIP 10 SOUTH, RANGE 26 EAST, W.M.

The storage of water allowed herein is subject to the installation and maintenance of an outlet pipe, or to provide other means to evacuate water when determined necessary by the Water Resources Director to satisfy prior downstream rights.

The right to store and use the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use at the place of use described.
