## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For rights perfected under original, enlargement or secondary permits)

This is to Certify, That OREGON TRUNK RAILMAY
of Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the
waters of Deschutes River , a tributary of Columbia River
Dike Water Station , for the purpose of domestic and locomotive supply at
under Permit No. 814 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered
of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1,
at page 168 , on the 18th day of November, 1914 ; that the priority of
the right hereby confirmed dutes from August 31, 1911; that the amount of
water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
exceed 0.40 cubic feet per second.
A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appartenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
Lot Four (4), in Section Seven (7), Township Two (2) South Range Sixteen (16) East of Willamette Meridian.
The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.  Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
