CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

J.H. AND O.C. GRAY
PRINEVILLE, OREGON 97754

confirms the right to use the waters of DEEP CREEK, a tributary of CROOKED RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 120.0 ACRES.

This right was confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County. The decree is of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the WATER RESOURCES DIRECTOR, in Volume 1, at Page 449. The date of priority is 1886.

The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed A REASONABLE AMOUNT FOR DOMESTIC AND STOCK USE AND 1.5 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FOR IRRIGATION, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW¼ NW¼ 30.0 ACRES
SE¼ NW¼ 15.0 ACRES
NE¼ SW¼ 40.0 ACRES
NW¼ SE¼ 35.0 ACRES


TOWNSHIP 15 SOUTH, RANGE 20 EAST, W.M.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 578, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered DEC 28 2001, approving Transfer Application 8827.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described and is subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.
