confirms the right to use the waters of ROUGH AND READY CREEK, a tributary of the ILLINOIS RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 11.9 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 13080. The date of priority is JUNE 21, 1938. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.238 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, SECTION 14, T 40 S, R 9 W, W.M..

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FIFTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE¼ SE¼	3.3 ACRES	(BROWN - TAX LOT 1002)
NE¼ SE¼	3.9 ACRES	(BUCK - TAX LOT 1000)
SE¼ SE¼	4.1 ACRES	(EMONDS - TAX LOT 1001)
SE¼ SE¼	0.3 ACRE	(BROWN - TAX LOT 1002)

The diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, a weir or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled.


The type and plans of the measuring device must be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work and the weir or measuring device must be installed under the general supervision of the Watermaster.

This certificate describes that portion of the water right confirmed by Certificate 76872, State Record of Water Right Certificates, NOT modified by the provisions of an order of the Water Resources Director entered JAN 14 2002, approving Transfer Application 8274.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
