CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

GRANDE RONDE VALLEY IMPROVEMENT DITCH COMPANY  
205 MAIN STREET  
LA GRANDE, OREGON 97850

confirms the right to use the waters of GRANDE RONDE RIVER, a tributary of SNAKE RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 127.62 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 25403. The date of priority is JANUARY 23, 1958. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 2.0 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, IF AVAILABLE AT THE ORIGINAL POINT OF DIVERSION DESCRIBED AS BEING WITHIN THE SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M., or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 32, TOWNSHIP 2 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.;  
640 FEET NORTH AND 190 FEET EAST OF THE S 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 32.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE 1/4 NW 1/4	35.68 ACRES
NW 1/4 NW 1/4	11.48 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4	40.23 ACRES
SW 1/4 NW 1/4	40.23 ACRES

SECTION 14

TOWNSHIP 3 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, W.M.

The water user shall install and maintain a headgate, an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted. The type and plans of the headgate and measuring device must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

The water user shall report total flow figures when requested by the Watermaster. The Watermaster may operate the headgate and monitor accuracy of the measuring device, as needed.

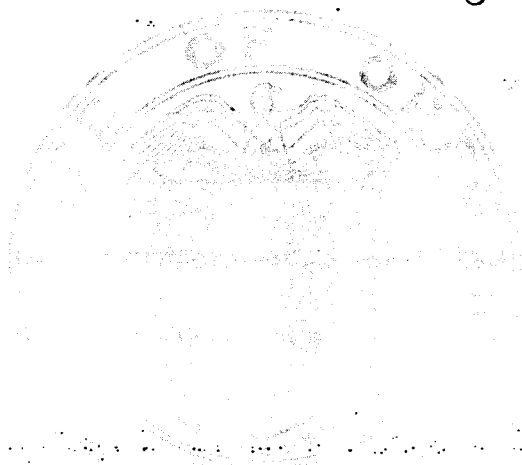
The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 29, 1995, and supersedes Certificate 32245, State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.
