confirms the right to use the waters of A WELL in the ROGUE RIVER BASIN, for SUPPLEMENTAL IRRIGATION OF 8.0 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-6827. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 27, 1973. This right is limited to not more than 0.1 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows: NE¼ SE¼, SECTION 16, TOWNSHIP 38 SOUTH, RANGE 1 WEST, W.M.; 245 FEET SOUTH AND 590 FEET WEST FROM THE EAST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second (or its equivalent) for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the right allowed herein for supplemental irrigation shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

0.1 acre SW1/4 NW1/4
1.0 acre NW1/4 SW1/4
SECTION 15
0.9 acre SE1/4 NE1/4
6.0 acre NE1/4 SE1/4

When in the judgement of the Watermaster it becomes necessary to install measuring devices: the diversion works shall include an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring the water to which the water user is entitled;

the type and plans of the measuring device shall be approved by the Watermaster before the beginning of construction work, and the weir or measuring device shall be installed under the general supervision of said Watermaster.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described. The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.

This certificate is issued to confirm an order of the Water Resources Director entered February , 2002, and recorded in Special Order Volume 56, Page 27, diminishing the water right from primary to supplemental irrigation. This Certificate supersedes Certificate 74181, State Record of Water Right Certificates.
