CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

ROGER AND CYNTHIA GROSSMAN 70455 LOWER BRIDGE WAY TERREBONNE, OR 97760

confirms the right to use the waters of WELL NO. 2 in the DEEP CANYON CREEK BASIN for IRRIGATION OF 84.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit G-4974. The date of priority is MARCH 13, 1972. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 1.05 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

NW 1/4 SW 1/4, SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.; 2380 FEET NORTH AND 4420 FEET WEST FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 19.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that in the event of a request for a change in point of appropriation, an additional point of appropriation or repair of this well, the quantity of water allowed herein together with any other right from this point of appropriation shall not exceed the capacity of this well at the time of perfection of this right.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

SW 1/4 NE 1/4 31.6 ACRES
SE 1/4 NE 1/4 20.1 ACRES
SE 1/4 NW 1/4 8.4 ACRES
NW 1/4 SE 1/4 22.7 ACRES
SW 1/4 SE 1/4 1.5 ACRES
SECTION 19
TOWNSHIP 14 SOUTH, RANGE 12 EAST, W.M.

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Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. The water user shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The water user shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
- C. The Director may require the water user to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the water user to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the water user to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the right. The Director may provide an opportunity for the water user to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF APPROPRIATION, PLACE OF USE AND USE approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered AUGUST 4, 1998, and ALONG WITH CERTIFICATE 75761, supersedes Certificate 65147 State Record of Water Right Certificates.

The issuance of this superseding certificate does not confirm the status of the water right in regard to the provisions of ORS 540.610 pertaining to forfeiture or abandonment.

The well shall be maintained in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The right to use water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
