CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

CHARLES M. MOORE AND LORING V. STEWART  
DAYVILLE, OREGON

confirms the right to use the waters of the JOHN DAY RIVER, a tributary of the COLUMBIA RIVER, for IRRIGATION OF 18.5 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 2355. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 9, 1915. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.23 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 3, T 13 S, R 27 E, W.M.; NORTH 59 DEGREES EAST 260 FEET FROM SW SECTION CORNER OF SECTION 3.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$       12.5 ACRES  
NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$       6.0 ACRES


SECTION 4
