confirms the right to use the waters of WOAHINK LAKE, a tributary of WOAHINK CREEK, for DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD.

This right was perfected under Permit 50123. The date of priority is MAY 11, 1987. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FOR DOMESTIC USE EACH YEAR, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 3 (NW 1/4 SW 1/4), SECTION 23, TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.; 900 FEET SOUTH AND 1430 FEET WEST FROM THE CENTER OF SECTION 23.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

LOT 3 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
SECTION 23
TOWNSHIP 19 SOUTH, RANGE 12 WEST, W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use without waste on the lands or place of use described. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use confirmed herein may be made only at times when sufficient water is available to satisfy all prior rights, including rights for maintaining instream flows.
